Haul Out Rates

Haul out, pressure wash, set up of stands and re-launch are all included in our rates. Additional charges may apply when extra crane time or labor is required to prep a vessel for use with spreader bars, removal of excessive marine growth, cleanup of runoff paint, or removal of items required to set slings. Additional charges are based on our General Yard rate plus hazardous waste disposal (if applicable).

The Spaulding crane has a working limit of 24,000 lbs or 12 tons. We are also tide dependent on hauls so when we arrange a haul out time we appreciate you delivering your boat on time. —Thank you

Labor & Storage Rates

Spaulding Marine Center charges hourly rates for our services. Estimates are provided for all work done and are subject to change once work begins.

Crane	\$375

Two days of free storage is provided after scheduled projects are completed. Storage fees are applied thereafter. Storage fees also apply when the owner has not authorized Spaulding Marine Center to work at least four hours of labor per work day.

Bottom Paint Packages

Bottom painting packages include:

Haul-out, Pressure wash, Setting stands, Vacuum sanding, Tape waterline, Painting and Launch. Two coats of Pettit Trinidad HD antifouling paint are rolled on. Bottom is presumed to be in good condition requiring standard preparation. Any additional preparation required is charged at the General Yard Rate.

Cleaning shafts, propellers, trim tabs, centerboards, sail drives or outboards are not included in the package. **An EPA fee of 3.75% will apply to all labor and materials purchased.**

Important Information

- All vessel owners must review and acknowledge our TERMS OF SERVICE prior to starting any DIY work at Spaulding Marine Center.
- Any owners planning to do work on their own boats or use a contractor must obtain approval from the Yard Manager and sign a BOATYARD WORK AGREEMENT prior to starting any work.
- Owners and contractors must complete all necessary insurance requirements and follow Spaulding Marine Center requirements to work on vessels in the yard. Failure to do so may result in the revocations of privileges to work at this yard.
- All customer representatives and/or guests must check in at the office upon arrival and must follow all yard rules, safety, and environmental regulations.
- Outside contractors are prohibited to work on vessels at the yard without prior consent.
- Boat owners, guests and subcontractors must abide by the operating hours of the yard. No work is to be conducted outside of regular yard hours of operation.
- If you see or create a spill, no matter how small, please report this to staff or the office immediately.
- Customers must not move, adjust, or otherwise touch the support stands.

- All ladders must be securely attached to the vessel.
- Customers that do not know how to properly secure a ladder shall not climb it. Ask a staff member for assistance.
- It is always the responsibility of the owner to leave their work area clean. If the area is left for SMC staff to clean, the cost will be added to your invoice.
- We do not allow customers to go aloft at any time.
- It is the responsibility of the customer to coordinate their activities with yard management.
- All customers personal gear and loose boat equipment must be securely stowed by the owner or taken out of the yard. The yard is not responsible for loss or damage of these items.
- Regular trash bins are to be used for regular trash only all other waste disposal must be treated accordingly. Please see a staff member for assistance in disposing your garbage.
- Pumping of the bilge is not permitted, on land or in the Bay at any time while at the SMC.
- Yard rules are posted outside on the main building wall.
- Smoking is not allowed inside the facility.
